All events start on time. We require that you are set up and ready to pour/serve at least 30 minutes ahead of scheduled start time. Late arrival may result in exclusion from the event. You do not need a local winery representative in order to participate in NOWFE. Please reach out to your local distributor to assist you.

The New Orleans Wine & Food Experience is a tasting event. We ask that you please help us keep the Experience's reputation in tact by following these recommendations:

- Keep your pours under 2 ounces
- Please refrain from serving people that have overindulged at the events
- At the end of the event, please put your partially full, any opened bottles and all unopened bottles under your table.

- Three 750 ml bottles
- Three 1L bottles, carafes or boxes
- Two 1.5 L Bottles
- Four 375 ml or 500 ml bottles
- Two 3L Boxes
- One 5L Box

### WINERIES DELIVERING THROUGH A DISTRIBUTOR:

All wine must be delivered by a licensed distributor with a zero-balance invoice. All incoming product must enter and exit the Hotel through the Hotel's loading dock. Distributors are not permitted to utilize valet parking and are required to make alternate parking arrangements in advance. All deliveries and pick-ups must be coordinated with the Hotel in advance. Make certain that ALL BOXES are clearly labeled with "NOWFE WINE AWARDS" and "Attention to Sherry Guyette". If it is not labeled, we can not guarantee that it will get delivered to the correct location within the hotel. Please note the entry number on the outside of the box.

Guidelines:

- Red wines poured must have a published retail value of \$65.00 or higher.
- White wines and Sparkling wines poured must have a published retail value of \$40.00 or higher.
- Wineries should provide six (6) bottles of each wine poured. This is to have enough to pour for the entire event. We ask that you use a 2oz pour.
- If you wish to register more than eight different (8) wines for Vinola, please contact Cate Ferguson | <u>cferguson@nocci.com</u>.
- ALL WINES submitted will be reviewed and approved by the Vinola Committee.
- There is an option to participate in the main part of the event or in our VIP Sparkling Wine Lounge.
- Winemakers and Principals will receive 1 room for 1 complimentary night in a NOWFE sponsor hotel. The deadline to reserve a room is May 3, 2024. Representatives will receive our exhibitor rate.
- Vinola allows a maximum of TWO representatives per wine table (including wine maker, pourer, owner, etc).

- The winery distributor is responsible for any leftovers, pick up and credit. If you do not have a distributor, the winery is responsible for any leftovers.

- Please be prepared to pour your wine or to have a representative from your distributor to pour.
- Tournament of Rosés allows ONE representative to pour your wine as we are limited in space.
- The winery distributor is responsible for any leftovers, pick up and credit. If you do not have a distributor, the winery is responsible for any leftovers.
- We are asking everyone participating & attendees to wear their favorite shade of pink!!
- There is an option to participate with a rosé or in a sparkling garden.

- The winery distributor is responsible for any leftovers, pick up and credit. If you do not have a distributor, the winery is responsible for any leftovers.
